As I write this diary for someone to look at, you've been wondering why I am very loyal and religious to my religion. Well the reason is that I want to live my life as a humble and honest man and being religious helps me to guide me in the right way of living life. I also want to live for a very long time and impact other lives.

I hope that I won't get enrolled and I hope that God will answer my prayers. God almighty please save the souls of the people who will be participating in the war, save them God speed.
